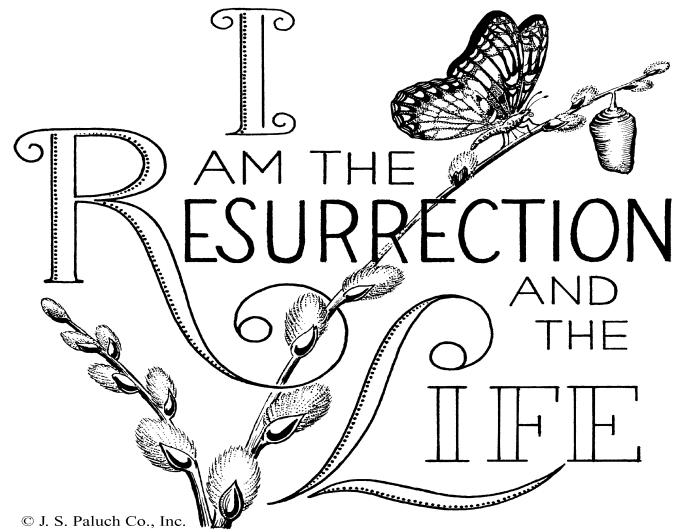

Dear Parishioners:

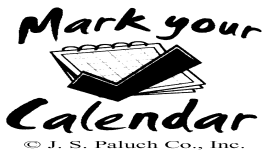
